Ultra Coat and Ultra Stain



It's tough to beat a factory finish applied with state-of-the-art equipment under rigorously controlled, ultra-clean conditions. There are two options to choose from, Ultra Coat and Ultra Stain*. All visible interior surfaces will be finished including exterior wood surfaces on our casement and awning products that are viewed when the sash is in the open position.

The Finishing Process

Sierra Pacific preps and finishes each wood component prior to window assembly, removing the additional steps of having to prep, sand, and finish an already assembled unit. So, once we have assembled your interior finished unit, it's ready to ship!


For both the Ultra Coat and Ultra Stain finishes, each component goes through a multi-step process of sanding, prepping, coating, and sealing.

While not always necessary, touch up of the finish should be expected on the jobsite.


Coverage Area

Planning on painting the interior of the unit on site? Choose our primed interior option, which like our Ultra finish process, we prep and apply a water based prime coat to the interior wood components before assembly.

Using a dark based paint color? Choose our black prime coat option to limit the number of coats needed for finishing.
